**SUBJECT: 2017/2018 GSNF PHD SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**



The application documents including the GPA of Undergraduate degree should be forwarded to the Director, GS **by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017.**

The application documents should include;

- An application for a scholarship addressed to the Director, Graduate School through the Dean/Director by the applicant detailing area of study/research.
- The applicant should include a PhD proposal and anti-plagiarism report whose similarity index does not exceed 15%.
- A reference letter from either the Supervisor/Dean/Director.
- A letter of admission for postgraduate programme (PhD) in the University.
- Certified copies of KSCE, undergraduate and masters certificates and transcripts.
- A curriculum vitae.
